Die Schriftzeichen des Phönizischen sind meines Wissens die ältesten.

YHWH

The term Tetragrammaton (from **Greek**, meaning "[a word] having four letters") refers to the **Hebrew** name of the **God of Israel**, **YHWH** used in the **Hebrew Bible**.

The Tetragrammaton occurs **6,828** times in the Old Testament, many of the **Dead Sea Scrolls** write the **Tetragrammaton** in **paleo-Hebrew script** which is the **Phoenician** characters.

YHWH in the Hebrew Script יהוה

YHWH is a transliteration, these four letters are usually **transliterated** from Hebrew as **IHVH** in **Latin**, **JHWH** in **German**, **French** and **Dutch**, and **JHVH/YHWH** in English. This has been variously rendered as "**Yahweh**" or as "**Jehovah**".

transliterated: is the practice of converting a text from one writing system into another in a systematic way.
